- Children should be well rested, fed, hydrated, and motivated to learn. Chipmunk Corner is a Ski and Ride learning center, and not intended to be a traditional daycare facility.
- Parent and student arrival time is 8:00am, and 7:30am on holidays. Late arrivals will be rescheduled for an afternoon class if available. We are not responsible for delays due to unforeseen circumstances affecting late arrivals, though we make attempts to accommodate guests as possible.
- One parent or guardian must remain on the mountain for the duration of the lesson, in case of emergency.
- Please label all personal items such as jackets, gloves, goggles, water bottles etc. Be sure to check for and collect all items at the end of the day. We are not responsible for items that are not labeled.
- To ensure the best quality experience we ask throughout the ski lesson not to distract your child so they can stay focused.
- Children enrolled in snow sport lessons must be able to use the restroom independently, no pull ups or diapers, without prior approval.
- Any student who refuses to participate in the lesson will be allowed to remain indoors until their parents arrive and a 30-minute grace period will be allowed, except at the end of the day.
- If any problem arises, such as illness, refusal to ski, an unruly child, communication to the parent/guardian will be in the form of a paging system or a message board at the bottom of lifts.
- Please accurately represent your child's age and ability for our staff and their fellow student's success.
